REFERENCE BOOKS

Value Line Investment Survey A comprehensive weekly investment survey of large, primarily American corporations. Rates securities for timeliness and safety. Includes a helpful index with lists of recommended stocks. A separate "Selection and Opinion" newsletter includes individual recommendations and model portfolios.

Value Line Small and Mid-Cap Investment Survey A weekly investment survey that covers many smaller corporations not covered in the above survey.

Value Line OTC Special Situations Survey Recommends smaller individual corporations and tracks them over time.

Chartist, Oberweis Report, and Prudent Speculator These monthly investment newsletters recommend specific stocks and maintain model portfolios of recommended equities.

Hulbert Financial Digest This monthly publication analyzes the performance of various financial newsletters.

Mergent's Dividend Achievers An annual volume that profiles over 280 companies that have increased their regular cash dividends for at least ten consecutive calendar years.

Standard and Poor's Outlook A weekly investment advisory service that highlights specific stocks. It also includes a master list of recommended stocks, model portfolios, and asset allocation recommendations. Also available on Standard and Poor's NetAdvantage database in the library or from home/office with a Niles library card.
