In WilsonSelectPlus UNDER: Child Development; Developmental Psychology; Human Development (You may want to narrow your search by including additional keywords)

You may want to type in words that describe different age groups and stages of life and, possibly, to type in additional keywords to narrow your search. (For example, if you are interested in studying teenagers, you might choose "teenagers" to describe the age group. You also might want to use the word "adolescents." You might use the word "adolescence" to describe the stage of life. You would probably also want to narrow your searches by using additional keywords that are specifically about the aspect of adolescent development that you would like to study.)
