### Medical care offered in exchange for groceries

exchange for bringing in non-perishable food items, patients could receive medical care for free next month. They can come in for check-ups, consultations or help for a fraction of what they were saving for Y2K, and they have leftover cans and groceries.

"It's not even something that people will need to go out and do," said Dr. Styros Bakis, a medical director of Health One, a medical and multi-discipline center in Morton Grove which is participating in the program for the seventh year.

If you can spare an extra bag of groceries next month, you could get free medical care.

For one week next month, Doctors Feed the Hungry, a statewide philanthropic group, is offering to donate its services in order to help feed needy families. In

Health One, 5818 Dempster Street, will offer medical care for new patients during the week of May 1. Patients are asked to call and schedule an appointment.

Dr. Bakis, also president of the Chicago Chiropractic Society, is one of three doctors at the facility offering services. Dr. Linda Ermann and Dr. Josefina Calvo-Garcia also offer services to offer medical, chiropractic, nutritional and rehabilitation services in exchange for food. Donations will benefit the Niles-Strook Food Pantry.

Suggested food items include canned meats, canned fruits and juices, peanut butter, cereals, as well as toilet paper, diapers, soap, tissue paper, paper towels and tissue paper.

The food pantry, which needs food for families year-round, has been especially busy during the food at this time of year, explained Genevieve Esterman who works at the pantry. The pantry receives the majority of its donations from the community during the months of November and December holidays.

"We've always wanted to give back to people who need us. As doctors, that's what our job is. We do what we can do in which we do that," Bakis explained.

The Health One clinic specializes in muscular-skeletal problems by providing physical therapy, massage, and orthopedic services, including the ability to control one's own destiny. We provide community integrated residential, vocational and respite services that are both appropriate and meaningful. We promote individual's rights and teach responsibility for life choices.

**Health / Fitness****How to Win At Losing Weight**

A 10-week program designed to help people lose weight through healthy food choices, exercise guidelines, nutrition assessment, a low-fat eating plan and behavior modification will be presented by Resurrection Medical Center, 7435 West Talcott Avenue.

Win At Losing Weight will be presented twice a week on Wednesdays from 6 to 7 p.m. beginning April 26 in the Sister Gregory Room on the ground

floor of Resurrection Medical Center. The program will be conducted by Dr. Robert Jan Fortina, a registered dietitian, and Carrie Zakarias, exercise physiologist.

Some of the topics that will be covered in the 10-week program include: Healthy food choices, an overview of essential nutrients, Are you fit or fat? Body composition, Setting goals, The ABCs of Behavior;

How to shop smarter in the supermarket; Restaurant survival - making better choices when eating out.

Participants will receive assertiveness training and learn stress management techniques and strategies for long-term success.

"Winning at losing weight isn't about dieting at all -- this program is for people who want to live a healthy, active, low-fat foods, and know more about how much can be eaten is what leads to long-term weight loss," and weight control."

Participants in the program will also learn about the importance of regular exercise in weight loss and weight control. "We find that exercise can be much more effective when regular exercise is part of the plan," said Zakarias. "Exercise -- which doesn't have to be strenuous -- not only helps you lose weight, it also reduces stress, improves your stamina and generally contributes to overall good health."

The cost for the entire 10-week program is \$100 and includes all course materials. Registration is required. For information and to register for Win At Losing Weight, call Resurrection's Health Management Department at 773-792-5022.

It's Monday morning and many pieces of exercise equipment is humming. Some people are rowing, others are working out on treadmills, recumbent bikes and stationary bicycles.

At the Resurrection's neighborhood health club, except almost all the 23 faces of those working out here are of older folks. They are placed in groups participating in the Chicago Thoracic Society of the American Lung Association of Metropolitan Chicago's Primary Care Management Program.

Debbie Baumgart, Supervisor of the Cardiac and Pulmonary Rehabilitation Department, seems excited as she explains another innovation for these patients to celebrate National Cardiac Rehabilitation Week.

Upon completion of Phase II, a patient graduates to an ongoing Phase III program, also referred to as progressive cardiovascular handouts, speakers and during Cardiac Rehab Week, heart healthy snacks. About 70 cardiac patients are now enrolled in Resurrection's Phase III program.

"Each day we're posing on one aspect of heart disease and, every Phase II or III patient who answers a question correctly has a chance to win prizes," Baumgart says.

In the cardiac rehabilitation program, a patient progresses through three levels, or phases, of care. Patients are admitted to hospital, soon after the patient has suffered a heart attack, had angioplasty or open-heart surgery. Phase I includes bedside exercises, getting up and walking, going up and down stairs, instruction on levels of physical activity when the patient goes home, and some education about risk factors such as diet, stress and smoking.
