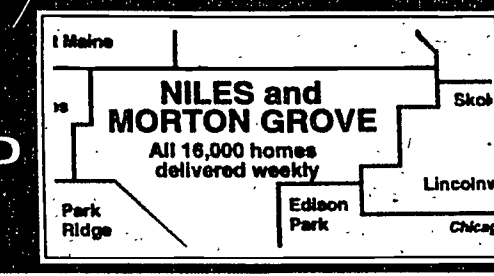

## Nicor advises customers to prepare for higher gas bills

Natural gas market prices continue to be higher than last year. Energy experts forecast that this will continue into the fall and winter heating season and Nicor Gas is encouraging customers to plan ahead.

For Nicor Gas customers, the August Gas Cost is 49.5 cents per therm, compared to 30 cents a year ago. The average residential customer's August bill should be about \$24, compared to \$18 last year.

If the trend continues, and weather is normal, customers can expect much higher fall and winter bills than last year. For example, the December 2000 Gas Cost could be close to 50 cents per therm compared to 35 cents last year. That could mean a bill of \$130 or more in December compared to last year's \$91 for an average residential customer.

Customers can prepare for higher bills several ways. Nicor Gas offers its Convenient Payment Plan that enables customers to build up a credit balance before the heating season. Through this plan, customers pay the same amount each month to cushion the impact of winter bills. Participants can even have their payments electronically paid from their checking or savings account. Sign up is easy. Another option is for customers to pay more than the payment amount due to build a credit. All balances earn a credit based on the 13-week Treasury Bill rate.

## Village of Niles 2000 Leaf Pickup Service

The Village of Niles will again offer leaf pickup service this year to residents. The leaf pickup program runs from mid-October through late November, and is provided to residents every other week according to the following schedule.

• For residents living East of Milwaukee Avenue, pickup begins on the following Mondays and continues through that week. Residents should place their leaves in the curb on the appropriate Monday for pickup during the week. Leaf pickup begins on the following dates:

- October 9th
- October 23rd
- November 6th
- November 20th

• For residents living West of Milwaukee Avenue, pickup begins on the following

Mondays and continues through that week. Residents should place their leaves in the curb on the appropriate Monday for pickup during the week. Leaf pickup begins on the following dates:

- October 16th
- October 30th
- November 13th

Loose leaves should be raked into the curb by Monday of the pickup week and be free of foreign materials such as grass, branches, plants and rocks. Leaves will not be collected if they are placed in plastic bags or boxes - all leaves must be loose.

Leaves placed for pickup on the appropriate Monday morning will be picked up during that week, not necessarily that Monday. To provide the leaf collection equipment better

Niles Police thank local media and residents for support

## Police: 'very strong case against rape suspect Lewis'

Niles law enforcement officials held a press conference Friday to thank residents, officers, and the local media for their efforts and support during the four month search leading to the arrest of the man believed responsible for the series of home invasions and sexual assaults on Asian women which have plagued the northwest suburbs and city since April.

Chief Gerald Sheehan told reporters that residents' vigilant phone calls and numerous tips were a great asset to investigators, and that the constant media coverage aided police by keeping residents informed and conveying safety instructions from law enforcement to readers.

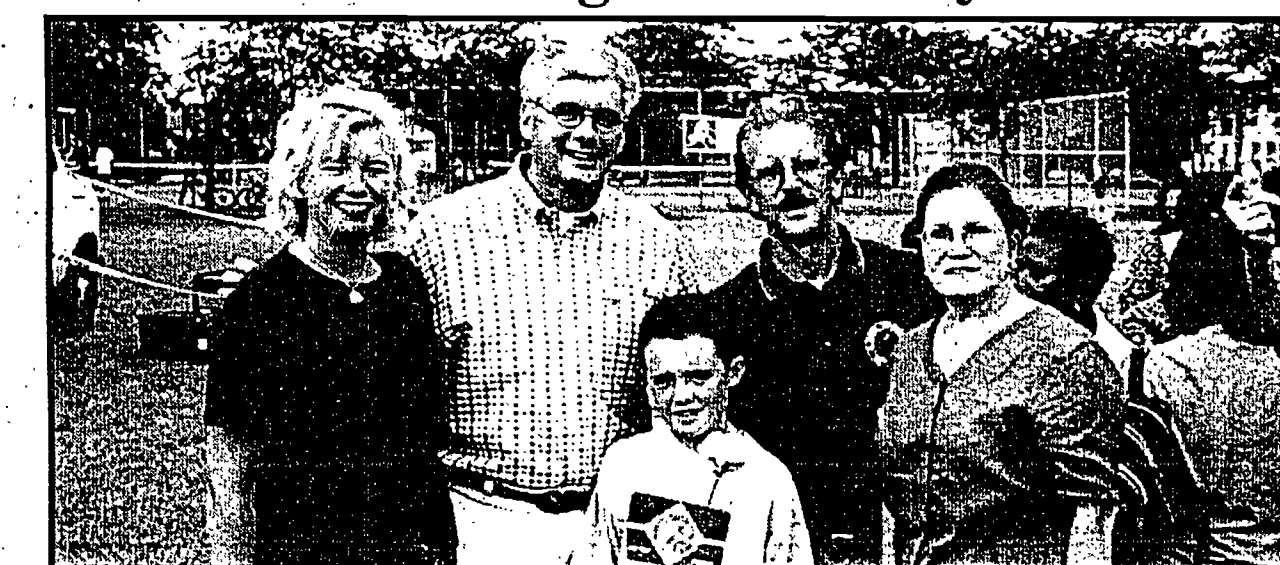
## Water Reclamation District tax levy decreases

Terrence J. O'Brien, President of the Board of Commissioners of the Metropolitan Water Reclamation District of Greater Chicago, announced that the tax levy for 1999 is reduced by \$1.96 million from 1998. The tax rate in effect for 1999 taxes has decreased 5.6% from 1998. The owner of a home assessed at \$100,000 would see his bill reduced by almost \$3.

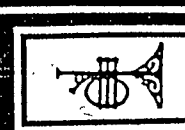

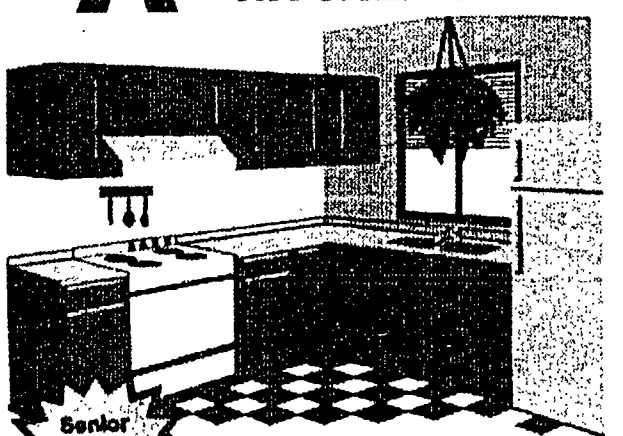

### Communication: the anti-drug

As a parent, you want what's best for your kids. And you know as your kids grow up they will face many temptations, including drugs. According to a study conducted by the Partnership for a Drug-Free America, only 27 percent of teens say they're learning a lot at home about the risks of drug use -- although virtually all parents in the United States say they've talked with their children about drugs.

This isn't an issue you can handle by having "the talk." When it comes to dangerous activities such as drug use, you need to have an ongoing discussion with your child. This can be difficult to do considering the numerous demands of work, school, after-school activities and religious and social commitments. However, the more time you take to communicate with your child about drugs and other sensitive subjects, the more at ease your child will be coming to you with questions or problems.

The following are suggestions that can help you become a more effective communicator, according to behavioral scientist, Tony Biglan, Ph.D.

1) Be a better listener -- ask

questions and be willing to listen to what your child has to say. Paraphrase what your child says to you to make sure you understand what they mean.

2) Give honest answers -- don't make up what you don't know. If your child asks you something and you don't know the answer, offer to find out -- better yet, make it a project to find out the answer together.

3) Don't react in a way that will cut off further discussion. This can be a challenge. If your child makes statements that shock you or are counter to your beliefs, try to turn them into a calm discussion of why your child thinks the way he or she does. A negative reaction to one subject may make your child apprehensive to start future discussions about other difficult subjects.

The most important thing for you to remember is to tell your children that you love them -- and tell them often.

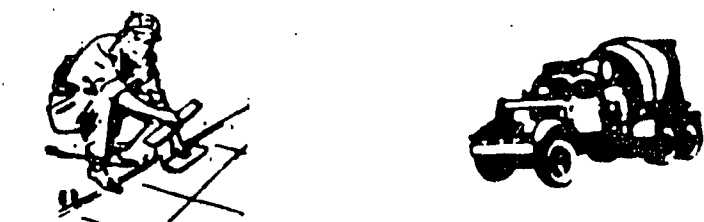

Mrs. Schurder said, "His attention to detail in helping us compile the statistics on our program activity is greatly appreciated."

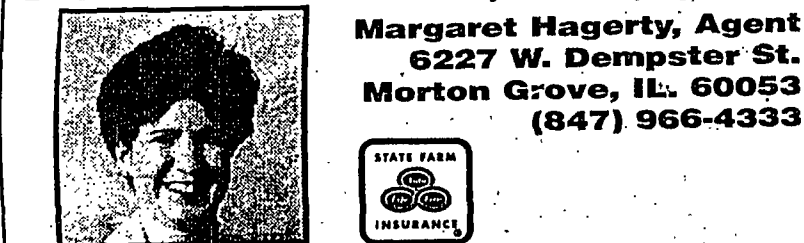

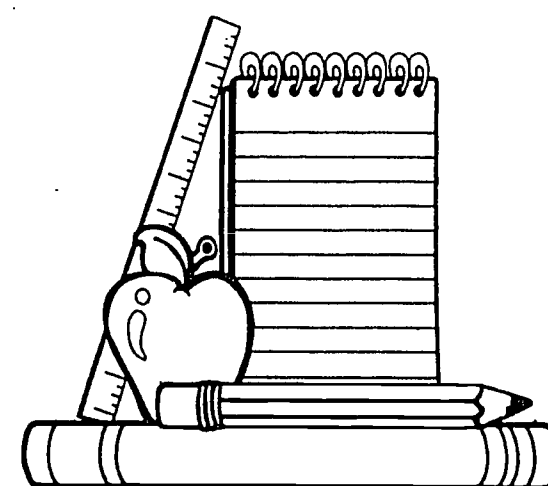

### Making home electronics more energy efficient

(NAPS)-According to Nielsen Research, in each of the 99.4 million American homes that have television sets, the TV is on more than 7.5 hours per day. But what

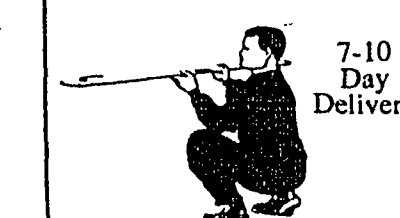

for the identification of the suspect.

Though bleeding from a blow to the scalp by the attacker, Sheehan said that the woman had the composure to gather a description of the car and a partial license plate number.

"That really broke the case," he said.

The result was the arrest of 35-year-old Mark Anthony Lewis from Chicago, who police say fled to the home of his wife's family Philippines on July 20.

Turned in by his wife and peacefully arrested in a shopping mall just over a week later, Lewis was returned to the United States where he has been charged with three counts of sexual assault and five counts of home invasion.

Agent Janet Thomas from the Chicago office of the Federal

Bureau of Investigations said that Lewis is not currently facing federal charges for impersonating a federal official in order to gain access into a woman's home, or for fleeing the country to avoid prosecution.

"We'll see what happens with the local charges," she said. Lewis may also face hate crime charges for his attacks on the Asian women, which would aggravate the current charges against him and could result in a weightier sentence.

However, Niles Deputy Chief Charles Giovannelli emphasized that while police feel that they have a very strong case against Lewis, "He is innocent until proven guilty."

Lewis is currently being held without bond at the Cook County correctional facility.

Although the Curriculum Council may be asked to review issues and make recommendations to the Board of Education, they act in an advisory capacity only. The Board of Education is responsible for determining policy.

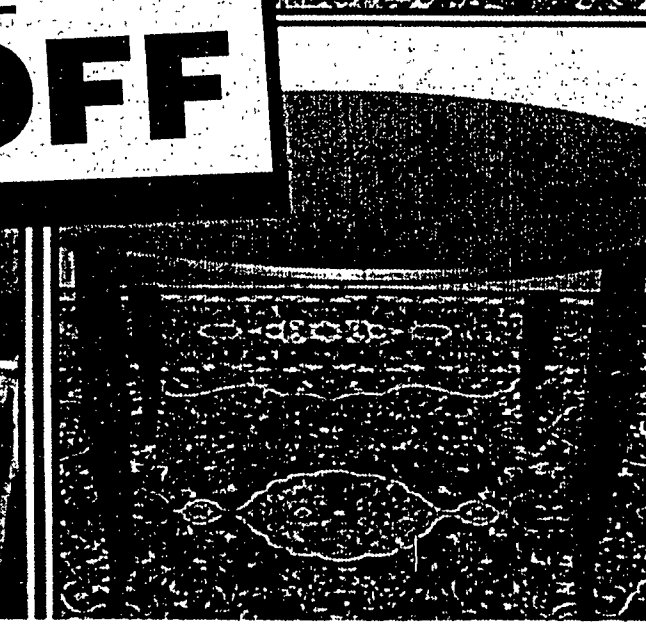
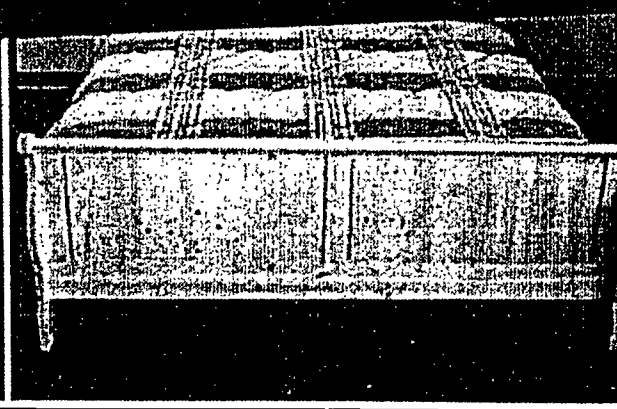
