

Removal of large neon sign sets tone for a cleaner downtown Edison Park



Another major step in the revitalization of downtown Edison Park occured recently when the 12foot high rooftop anchored neon sign of World Wide Liquors, 6715 Northwest Highway, was removed. The work, which cost \$1,900 was coordinated by World Wide Liquors and the Edison Park Chamber of Commerce and paid with funds received from the Illinois FIRST program. Plans are underway to use some of these funds to remove the support poles still attached to roofs of their nearby stores. This should clear signage clutter from storefronts, enhance the overall aesthetic appearance and encourage more businesses to opt for surface signage. World Wide Liquors will now beautify its facade by adding an awning with surface signage and make other related improvements. The Edison Park Chamber will continue to implement the goals of its beautification program and encourage more merchants to switch to surface signage.
