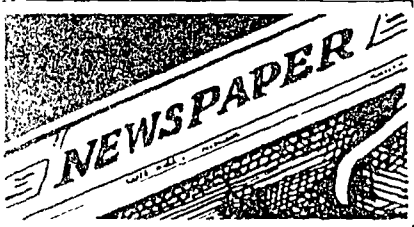
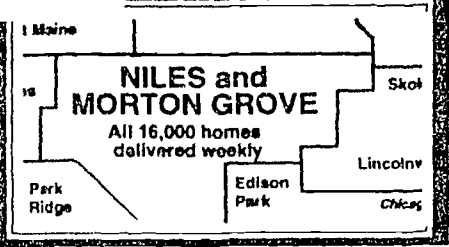

## Lower cost means second look for GIS

Niles moved closer to getting a geographic information system (GIS), when officials revised the projected cost downward.

When the village looked at such a system a few months ago, its cost--over \$577,000 including hardware and software--was a major concern.

The newness of it all leaves some uncharted areas, legislation-wise. Department of Agriculture officials have been discussing whether kennel laws should be revised to include these facilities, which at present require no license, said spokesman John Herath.

## Tracy Nicole Frey receives Veterinary Medicine Award



Tracy Frey, shown at right with Veterinary Centers of America student liaison Andrea Sangster, received a VCA Student Scholarship at the College's spring awards ceremony.

Tracy Nicole Frey, now a fourth-year veterinary student, was honored recently at the University of Illinois College of Veterinary Medicine's annual awards program. Frey is the daughter of James and Carmie Frey of Niles.

Frey was the recipient of a Veterinary Centers of America Student Scholarship. The award is given to one or more second- or third-year veterinary students based upon an essay on how the University of Illinois could better develop strategic relationships with corporate veterinary medicine, general practitioners, industry, and other animal health-related constituents. It consists of \$1,000 to be applied to tuition and fees and a College certificate. The award is sponsored by Veterinary Centers of America, Inc.

Frey graduated from Niles West High School, Skokie, in 1995. She earned a degree in biology from the University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign in 1998.

At the College of Veterinary Medicine, Frey is the president of Omega Tau Sigma, the professional veterinary fraternity, as well as the Student Veterinary Emergency and Critical Care Society (SVECCS). She is also co-recorder for the international SVECCS organization and a member of the American Veterinary Medical Association, the Illinois State Veterinary Medical Association, and the Veterinary Emergency Critical Care Society. Frey plans to become board certified by the American College of Veterinary Surgeons, which requires an additional four to five years of internships and residencies after completing the DVM degree.

The College of Veterinary Medicine is one of only 27 veterinary schools in the United States and the only one in Illinois. The veterinary medicine curriculum is a four-year program leading to a doctoral degree.

Exercise and security

Workout centers in the area can be targets for petty-thievery and pilfering, according to recent coverage on the subject.

In two Morton Grove facilities, Bally Total Fitness and Prairie View Center, gym members complained that they found locks broken off and items missing after working out, according to police reports. A report states that a non-member was seen on premises but not engaged in any exercise activity near the time of the incidents.

Problems can result when patrons come to exercise directly from work, and bring items like jewelry into the locker rooms, if their profession requires that they be well-presented.

According to police reports some major loot has been lifted from lockers. A purse containing three gold chains valued at \$1,500, \$300 in cash, a cell phone and a credit card were

stolen in early May from a locked locker at Bally's. Some facilities offer special secure lockers for valuables which are under watchful eyes of attendant staff.

## Niles' budget plans conservatively for fiscal year 2001-2002

Village minutes from the Fiscal Year 2001-2002 Budget Hearing held on April 23 present the accomplishments of last year's budget, and introduce safeguards for what the mayor indicates may be an economically tough year.

"If our local economy throws a curve at us, we have some things in place as contingency plans," stated Village Finance Director George Van Geem.

However, the new Budget is significantly based on such conservative sales tax revenue projections that the Village could end the year relatively unscathed.

Although sales tax revenue increased by eight percent over the last fiscal year, the 2001-2002 Budget assumes sales tax revenues will only grow a conservative two percent.

Therefore, rather than assume last year's sales tax revenue of \$18,532,000 will grow by additional \$1,482,560 (eight percent) this year, the Village Budget only projects collecting \$370,640 in additional sales tax revenue for 2001-2002.

Over half of the new budget's General Fund Revenue comes from sales tax. Van Geem called it the Village's "single most important revenue source."

A new Debt Service Fund col-

lecting 1/4 percent of sales tax dollars brought in \$2.3 million dollars this year, with \$1 million currently committed towards paying down debt.

Other revenue sources include the annual property tax levy increase of 4.9 percent and the four percent water rate increase.

Assistant Finance Director Scott Neukirch stated that these were the only increases in taxes or fees caused by the Budget, pointing out that the annual property tax levy is below five percent, as the Village prefers. The four-percent water rate reflects an earlier rate hike from the City of Chicago, Niles' supplier, and brings the water rate to \$3.08 per 1,000 gallons.

"Even with this increase, the Village water rate is still among the lowest in the area," stated Neukirch.

Expenses were down 6.2 percent from the Fiscal Year 2001 Budget. Van Geem stated that expenses were within 1/2 percent of this year's budgeted amounts, even with a surprise increase in energy costs.

The minutes close with Mayor or Blase thanking Department Heads and staff, then encouraging them to try and reduce every line-item on their respective budgets at least 10 percent by

the end of the year.

"This will lead us in the direction that we want to go... and enable us to at least come out even at the end of the year."

## Niles board OKs budget, abates tax levy

On May 22 Niles trustees both approved the budget for the coming fiscal year and voided a portion of property tax levy for the past fiscal year.

The \$4.4 million of taxes that property owners would have paid to service bond debt dating back to 1995 will now be paid by existing village funds. The revenue replacing taxpayers' funds came from the village's one-quarter percent home-rule sales tax, as well as from water revenues and tax-increment financing, said Niles Finance Director George Van Geem.

"When the village has other funds that can be used for debt servicing, we'd prefer to use them and advise the county accordingly," Van Geem said. With notification, the county assessor will not bill homeowners via their tax bills.

The new budget figure remains as proposed, at \$60,256,063.

Korpan's last day in office was May 7. He will use sick days and vacation time to fulfill his contract term which ends July 1.

Korpan was employed with the district since Dec. 1992.

## Stephen Ministry expands caregiving at Morton Grove Community Church

Three members of Morton Grove Community Church were among 484 pastors and church leaders at a Stephen Series Leader's Training Course held from April 22, 2001 to April 28, 2001 in St. Louis, Missouri. Ms. Judy Adams, Ms. Joyce Sienkowski, and Ms. Patricia Mathis attended the seven-day training event hosted by the St. Louis-based Stephen Ministries organization. Participants came from across the U.S., Canada, and South Korea to learn how to implement and direct Stephen Ministry, a system of Christian caregiving, in their congregations.

"Stephen Ministry gives Morton Grove Community Church an effective way to train and organize members to provide one-to-one Christian care to individuals struggling with a crisis such as grief, divorce, loneliness, relocation, hospitalization, terminal illness, or unemployment," said Rev. Michael Winters. "All Christians are called to care for and love one another — it's not

just the pastor's job. By equipping laypeople we can help them fulfill their calling as Christians and also expand the amount of caring ministry available through Morton Grove Community Church."

Ms. Judy Adams, Ms. Joyce Sienkowski, and Ms. Patricia Mathis were trained as Stephen Leaders at the event. One of their next steps will be to recruit, select, and train members of Morton Grove Community Church to be Stephen Ministers, the ones who will provide one-to-one care. They will then match each Stephen Minister with an individual in need of care and provide the Stephen Ministers with ongoing supervision and continuing education.

Stephen Ministry began in 1975 when Dr. Kenneth C. Haug, a pastor and clinical psychologist in St. Louis, Missouri, trained parishioners to help meet the needs for care in his congregation. The ministry was so successful that other congregations became interested, and Haug founded the Stephen Ministries organization. Since then, more than 7,000 congregations have been involved in Stephen Ministry. They represent 90 denominations and come from all 50 states, nine Canadian provinces, and 20 other countries.

The Stephen Ministries organization annually hosts six Leader's Training Courses across the U.S. At these courses, over 37,000 pastors and church leaders have been trained as Stephen Leaders. They in turn have trained almost 300,000 church members as Stephen Ministers. An estimated three-quarters of a million people have received the formal care of a Stephen Minister and millions more have been touched in an informal way.

## Maine mental health director to retire in July

John W. Hoffman, executive director of the Maine Center for Mental Health, will retire from his position on July 27 after 19 years of service to the community.

Maine Center serves the mental health needs of Maine Township and residents of Park Ridge, Des Plaines and parts of Niles, Morton Grove, Glenview and Rosemont. Its program in-

cludes clinic services, case management, supported living and rehabilitation programs.

Hoffman said he is proud of the accreditation that Maine Center holds. Their accreditation for a number of programs was renewed for a second three-year period through January 2004.

In a report on mental health and mental illness issued in December, 1999, Surgeon General David Satcher states that mental illness is the second leading cause of disability in the United States, affecting one in five Americans of all ages.

(NAPS)—Caffeine has been enjoyed by millions of people around the world for centuries. In one form or another, the average American consumes about 200 to 300mg of caffeine per day, and many say caffeine helps energize them and perform at their peak. What many people may not know is that caffeine has been used to help treat headaches for many years. Caffeine has also been added to prescription and over-the-counter pain relievers to boost their efficacy.

as much as 40 percent. In addition, the panel reviewed safety data and concluded that caffeine, when used properly, is not addictive and poses no health risk for most people.

According to Jerome Goldstein, MD, director of the San Francisco Headache Clinic and chair of the expert panel, caffeine offers another benefit. "Because medications that contain caffeine work faster, there is less likelihood that people will need to take more of the medicine, and the risks of unwanted side effects are reduced."

To help consumers understand these findings, the National Headache Foundation has developed a new information brochure, *New Perspectives on Caffeine and Headache*, that offers new ways to help people understand the relationship between caffeine and headache and help them make a well-informed decision about treatment. Consumers can also learn ways to measure their caffeine consumption and gain a better understanding of the role caffeine plays in treating headaches.

"We wanted to bring consumers the opinions of experts to help them make the right decisions about treating their headaches," says Suzanne Simons, executive director of the National Headache Foundation. "Our hope is that the findings of this panel and the information in the brochure will help eliminate any confusion headache sufferers may have regarding what triggers their headaches and how to treat them."

The *New Perspectives on Caffeine and Headache* brochure addresses the science behind caffeine's headache-fighting properties. By increasing the production of stomach acid, caffeine helps the body absorb headache medicines more quickly. Caffeine also constricts certain blood flow and eases pressure associated with certain headaches, such as painful migraines. The brochure offers a quiz that helps people determine how much caffeine they consume on a daily basis, a list of the most common sources of caffeine and a chart to gain a better idea of their weekly caffeine intake. Common questions about caffeine are also addressed, such as:

- Can I become addicted to caffeine?
- What happens when I stop consuming caffeine?
- How can I avoid rebound headaches and caffeine withdrawal?

### Minimally invasive kidney surgery reduces complications, pain and recovery time

Jeanette Kosta, 67, of Niles needed a cancerous tumor removed from her kidney, but traditional surgery would have been dangerous. Kosta has diminished lung capacity due to a previous illness. A long, invasive surgery could have affected Kosta's breathing and put her at risk for developing pneumonia. Doctors at Advocate Lutheran General Hospital offered Kosta an alternative. A minimally invasive surgery called laparoscopy. "With less surgery, there was less recuperation and I was able to get up out of bed quickly," said Kosta.

"Laparoscopic surgery is well established, but using this procedure to operate on kidneys is a new application of the technology," according to Gordon R. Gluckman, M.D., a urologic surgeon at Lutheran General Hospital. The operation involves making small incisions in the abdomen to permit the insertion of instruments and a small camera that is connected to a monitor to guide the surgeon's work. "The visualization is great," said Dr. Gluckman. "The camera magnifies everything, which

makes identification of blood vessels and lymphatics easier."

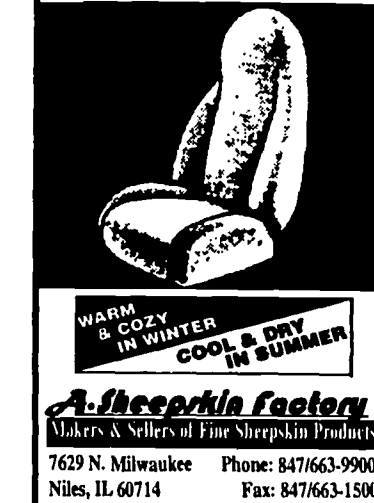
Laparoscopy is an improvement over the traditional surgery, which involves a painful incision. There are many benefits to this new alternative: shorter hospital stay, quicker recovery time, reduced post-operative discomfort and less noticeable scarring. Edward Brandon, 75, of Morton Grove was recuperating at home less than 48 hours after having a kidney removed using laparoscopic surgery. "Within a week and a half I was driving and running errands," said Brandon. Within three weeks Brandon was able to return to work.

"Laparoscopic surgery is not for everyone, but for the right candidate, it can be very satisfying," said Dr. Gluckman.

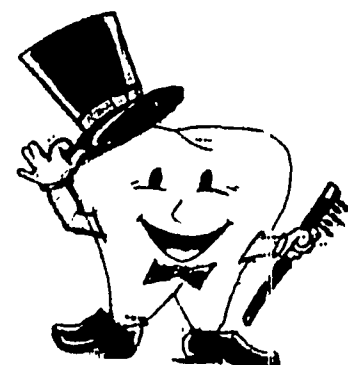

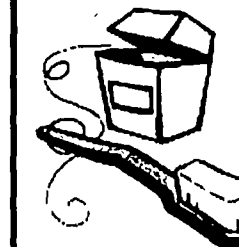

### A second chance to improve women's bones

(NAPS)—The loss of estrogen at menopause causes bone deterioration to accelerate, leaving women at a real risk for developing osteoporosis later in life.

However, a recent study to evaluate the long-term effects of estrogen replacement therapy found that women who start ET at age 65 can actually gain back bone, prevent further bone loss and decrease their rate of fracture compared to women who use it early and then stop.

"As women age, their risk of fracture increases," said Dr. Sarah Berga, associate professor of OB/GYN, Division of Reproductive Endocrinology, University of Pittsburgh School of Medicine. "It is important that women in their 60s and 70s understand they can still take measures to prevent the disabling complications of low bone mass."

Younger women who have undergone a hysterectomy along with the removal of the ovaries are especially at risk for osteoporosis because they will be without estrogen longer than women who undergo menopause naturally. Unfortunately many women discontinue estrogen when their symptoms (hot flashes, night sweats) subside.

For these women, Climara\* (estradiol transdermal system) can provide the lowest estrogen dose clinically proven to prevent osteoporosis — an attractive option for women returning to estrogen in their 60s and 70s.

"Continuous long-term treatment is beneficial in preventing the onset of osteoporosis," said Dr. Berga. "For women who go through early menopause due to surgery and therefore become estrogen deficient at an earlier age, long-term ERT at low doses is an important strategy in combating this disease."

Twenty-eight million Americans are at risk for osteoporosis, a debilitating disease that is characterized by a deterioration of the bones until they become frail and susceptible to fracture. One in two women over the age of 50 will have an osteoporosis-related fracture in their lifetime, most commonly of the hip, spine or wrist.

### Services for today's health conscious women

(NAPS) -- Today's women are more health conscious than their mothers and as a result more likely to get the health services they need.

This is especially true when it comes to mammograms, OB/GYN care and postmenopausal care. In response, more medical centers are being created that cater specifically to women and their busy schedules.

By focusing women's care in one center and providing schedules that factor in work hours, these centers make it easier for women to get the care they need.

A good example is the South Carolina Comprehensive Breast Center at Palmetto Richland Memorial Hospital in Columbia, SC, which has grown from 3,000 annual examinations to currently more than 14,000 per year.

The busy facility is expected to double its volume over the next three years, says director Dr. Tommy Cupples, proving there is demand for facilities that focus on women's health.

"Breast cancer is a disease that is complex to diagnose and treat," said Dr. Cupples, a leading specialist in mammography, digital mammography, breast ultrasound, image-guided needle biopsy techniques and computer-assisted diagnosis (CAD) for mammography. "In general, the large medical centers that are able to make a commitment to subspecialize in treating women's health may be able to make a difference for women in early diagnosis and treatment. However, the important thing is to be proactive and get an exam -- there are very dedicated and capable pro-

fessionals at small hospitals and clinics across the nation."

Equipping hospitals, clinics and women's health centers with some of the latest equipment can save time lost to repeating tests while new technologies may increase the accuracy of diagnosis and treatment. New equipment also can replace some invasive procedures -- such as surgical biopsy -- with non-invasive, high-quality diagnostic ultrasound exams or minimally invasive vacuum-assisted core biopsies.

Women's centers are investing in advanced diagnostic equipment, such as the Siemens Mammomat 3000 Nova, which combines advanced digital spot mammography technology with a design that optimizes the x-ray beam for the highest quality image at the lowest possible dose. The system's design also incorporates an automatic system that determines optimal breast compression for best image quality and greatest patient comfort.

And while mammography is the best single way to detect early breast cancer, breast care centers like the one at Palmetto Richland Memorial Hospital are now utilizing high-quality ultrasound systems, such as the Siemens SONOLINE Elegra. The Elegra is used to guide biopsies, or to gather additional information that can increase the diagnostic confidence of simple breast cysts, for example, which may render an invasive biopsy unnecessary.
