The Nelson family contributed to the school by donating library books.

The school wanted a way to thank them and decided this concert would be the venue.

Music teacher Anne Krause planned the program, called "Connect with Music." In honor of the special guests, Krause fashioned a little play to tie songs together and to highlight Viola Nelson.

Footnotes: Both Viola's son Lynn Nelson and his wife Trudy taught in District 63 about 30 years ago.

Melzer School is named after the other original teacher, Emma Melzer, who taught upper grades.

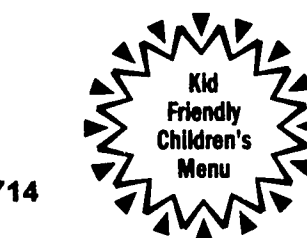

## 8-year-old rescues dogs

Walking to school, Daniell Beltran, of the 8300 block of Mango Avenue in Morton Grove, heard a smoke alarm.

As he approached the source, he smelled smoke.

Instead of continuing on, Daniell returned home and asked his mother's help.

His mother, who doesn't speak English, came with him to the bus stop, and together they got a neighbor to summon the Morton Grove Fire Department to the home of Iris Nason.

Nason says she foolishly left the house, forgetting to turn off the burner under a pot cooking on the stove.

The damage was mostly smoke, but Nason's three toy poodles would have succumbed before too long, she was told by fire fighters.

Fire fighters freed the dogs into fresh air and they are fine now, Nason said.

She considers herself extremely lucky that Daniell was around. "Someone else might have just passed by," she said.

Daniell attends Madison School.

Daniell's father, who works at Evanston Hospital, says he is proud both of his son and his wife.

## Demand for Assistance and Food Donations Increase

Due to the tough economic times, calls from residents to Maine Township for assistance are up 50 percent from a year ago with no end in sight.

"We predict that our caseload will continue climbing during the rest of 2003," says Maine Township Supervisor Bob Dudyecz. "A lot of people are hurting out there. We are trying our best to help as many as possible."

He adds that economic conditions are difficult for many since our area's low-income families must depend, at times, on public assistance and local food pantries just to get by. During the holiday season we see an outpouring of generosity from our residents but after January there is a noticeable drop in food donations. For example, February was the highest non-holiday month on record for food distribution.

The use of the Maine Township Emergency Food Pantry is up. According to pantry Storekeeper Carol Langan, the Pantry regularly helps hundreds of families every month.

"The need is increasing as the economy is hit by massive layoffs," Langan says. "Unfortunately, the Pantry is running low on some essential food items and is seeking emergency donations from area companies and individuals to help meet the increased need."

"This is a busy time for the Pantry and our supply of food is running low," Langan adds. "As current economic times get even tougher, the need to aid local residents will go up even more. These conditions put a great demand on social services and food pantry supply levels."

Any contributions of non-perishable food and money are always appreciated, the most pressing needs are for peanut butter, jelly, spaghetti sauce, canned fruit, chunky soups, and large cans or plastic bottles of juice especially apple, orange and grape flavors.

"We are encouraging agencies, schools, and organizations to organize food drives throughout to

help meet the need," Langan says. Individuals and groups are encouraged to contact her for a copy of the "Wish List" of food donations needed.

Donations may be brought to Maine Town Hall, 1700 Ballard Rd., Park Ridge on Monday-Friday between 9 a.m. and 5 p.m. For questions or assistance with large deliveries, contact the Maine Township Emergency Food Pantry at (847) 297-2510.

## Notre Dame Students Receive Leadership Award

Notre Dame High School for Boys distributed the Kevin A. Rapacz Memorial Leadership Award to four of its young men at an all-school Mass on May 1. The award is a scholarship given in recognition for the individual's service and leadership to Notre Dame High School and the civic community.

The scholarships are each equal to one-fourth the next year's tuition at Notre Dame. One recipient is chosen from each class to receive the award. The senior recipient will put that money towards his college tuition. Kevin's parents Ken and Barbara Rapacz presented the awards.

This year the scholarships went to the following students: John Swoboda '06 (St. Paul of the Cross), Miles Shockley '05 (St. Sabina), Omar Franco '04 (St. John Brebeuf), and Kevin Locallo '03 (St. Eugene).

Over 64 Notre Dame High School students have been honored with the Rapacz Leadership Award/Scholarship.

Kevin Rapacz '86 lettered in football and baseball all four years and was Vice-President of the Student Council at Notre Dame. He had just completed his first year of study at the University of Wisconsin-Madison, when he was tragically killed in an automobile accident in May, 1987.

Sixty students have been recipients of the Leadership Award since its inception in 1988.

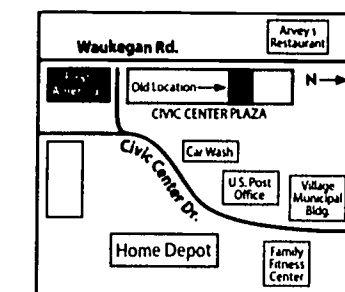

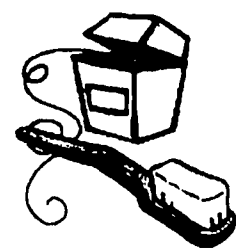

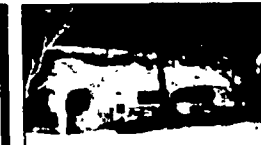

## D207 to keep lead-teacher positions

Maine Township High School District 207 approved cost reductions that total \$214,000, but opted to keep lead-teacher positions intact.

Lead teachers serve as aides to department chairmen. In a case where a chair is based at another school, the lead teacher provides day-to-day chair duties. A lead teacher also may have expertise that a department chairperson does not.

District 207 Superintendent Steven Snider called the lead-teacher matter essentially resolved.

When the board did not remove the positions in art, drama and foreign language, Board President Edward Mueller suggested that the board remove the recommendation instead.

Earlier in the year the elimination of lead teachers was regarded as a potential cost savings.

The \$214,000 savings comes from eliminating a driver's education teacher at Maine West High School and a librarian's position at Maine East High School.

In each case those teachers are about to retire and will not be replaced.

## Area braces for West Nile Virus

Attendees at a forum held recently in Skokie to address the West Nile Virus wanted answers: why were Skokie and Evanston hit so hard by the disease outbreak in Summer 2002?

Linn Haranis of the Illinois Department of Public Health provided one reason—he said that investigators found far more water-filled catch basins in virus-heavy areas than would be expected.

State representatives from Glenview, Evanston and Northbrook, Cook County commissioners Larry Suffredin and Joan Murphy, and U.S. Rep. Jan Schakowsky, D-9th, attended.

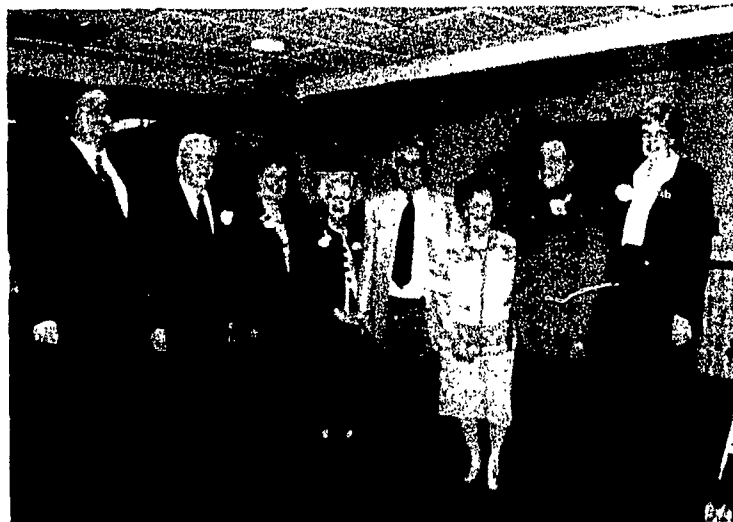
Schakowsky urged education to combat West Nile outbreaks in the coming season. In this area, we need that coverage in foreign languages, as well. Schakowsky said.

Schakowsky is sponsoring HR 342, which would provide matching grants to local governments to combat the dis-

ease. The bill passed in the House and is awaiting action in the Senate.

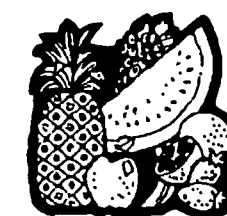

## D207 rules out longer English classes

Attendees at District 207's recent board meeting took a stand against a proposal to increase English class time for freshmen and sophomores.

The proposal to bump up freshman and sophomore English classes from one 45-minute period to a 70-minute session was opposed by all speakers.

Of approximately 150 district residents who attended the meeting, about 30 addressed remarks to the board.

Objections raised by the teaching staff were, for one, that remedial measures be targeted for certain students, and not blanketed on the entire student body.

An English teacher objected, saying that sacrificing time spent on non-English courses also meant sacrificing a well-rounded education.

A drama teacher suggested that another way for the district to support English instruction is to allow electives courses to reinforce English instruction through its electives courses.

District Superintendent Steven Snider stated the district's objective is to improve reading, grammar, vocabulary and writing.

A recent testing on the 2002 Prairie state exam has presented the district with an opportunity

for improvement, Snider said. The test results showed that 45 percent of Maine East, 20 percent at Maine South and 38 percent at Maine West students, failed to meet reading standards.

Snider said the district has formed a committee to study the matter and that a reading summit is being planned.

Both parents and teachers will be invited to participate in the summit.

Pfizer, Inc. will close two locations in Skokie over the coming 18 months, the company has announced.

Saying the company is "too geographically diverse to be productive or efficient," it will close some of its 25 research and development sites worldwide.

About 1,500 research and administrative positions are based here in the Chicago area, most of those in Skokie, a company spokeswoman said.

Other Pfizer locations in Mount Prospect and Elk Grove Village will also close.

Pfizer bought Pharmacia Corp. for \$57 billion in April.

The two Skokie locations were previously part of Pharmacia, with offices at 4901 Searle parkway and 5200 Old Orchard Road.

## Veterans Memorial Day Association of Park Ridge

Commander Nicholas Pistolis of the Park Ridge V.F.W. Post 3579 has announced that planning for the annual Park Ridge Memorial Day Parade is now rapidly drawing to a close.
