

Morton Grove Village Attorney Resigns post Jan. 1

orton Grove's long time village attorney is resigning his post effective Jan. 1, 2004. Gabriel Berrafato has served as corporation counsel for the village

under three different mayors, having accepted his first appointment to the post in the late 1970's from then Mayor Richard Flickinger. In his letter of resignation, Berrafato asks that he not be reappointed to the village position when his term is up at the end of this year.

"The village is becoming very busy and doing a lot of things," said Berrafato. "I'm a one man office. It became more work in recent years and not less." Berrafato was recently named a Senior Counselor by the Bar Association and the Illinois Supreme Court because of his 50 years of continuous practice.

"I'd like to spend more time on real estate, estate and probate work," said Berrafato. "It allows you to spend more time with old clients, not only as their attorney, but as friend and family. I represent their children and their children's children." Berrafato says he moved his young practice to Morton Grove from Chicago in the early 1970s to open a partnership with fellow attorney, James Orphan, who also served as village attorney. Berrafato and his

wife raised seven children in Morton Grove. After serving as village attorney under Flickinger and former Mayor Jules Bode, Berrafato took a hiatus from the position until 1991, when he was reappointed to the post by then Mayor Richard Hohs. He stayed on when current Mayor Dan Scanlon took over the mayor's office.





mined by the Assessor of Cook County.

The Bugle

It is the duty of the Assessor to appraise all taxable real property in Cook County at its fair cash value as of January 1, 2003. Fair cash value is described as what the property would bring at a voluntary sale in the normal course of business or trade. The Assessor is required by law to assess said property in a fair and just manner.

The Assessor does not determine property taxes. Property taxes are determined by the spending needs and requests of municipali ties, school boards, park districts and other local government agen cies which provide public services to property owners. The Assessor's sole responsibility is to estimate the value of real estat property.

In Cook County, real property is classified according to its use. The classification system is used to determine the percentage of the fair cash value at which the real property is assessed for purposes o taxation. Accordingly, real property is assessed at only a fraction of its fair cash value, depending on its use and classification.

Changes in assessment for land and improvements are listed separately. The dimensions of the land are also listed:

- A Acres
- B Back Lot
- N Irregular Lot

S - Square Feet

Cook County uses a Permanent Index Number (P.I.N.) system as a means to identify individual real estate parcels. The PiN consists of a 14-digit number. The first two digits identify the area or survey township; the second two digits identify the sub-area or section; the next three digits identify blocks.

Blocks are defined as follows:

Blocks 100 to 199 are located in the N.W. Quarter Blocks 200 to 299 are located in the N.E. Quarter Blocks 300 to 399 are located in the S.W. Quarter Blocks 400 to 499 are located in the S.E. Quarter

The next three digits in the series identify the specific parcel or lot. The last four digits, (where applicable), identify individual condominium units, non-operating railroad parcels or leasehold's of exempt parcels.

Whenever possible, the assessment list will be listed by the street name and the street or house number of the parcel. However, the Cook County Assessor's Office official records rely on permanent Property Index Numbers (P.I.N.) only. No assessment of real property shall be considered invalid due to an incorrect listing.


